

Criteria for Granting Financial Assistance

- Should be an approved surgery/treatment.
- Surgery/ treatment should be performed at an approved hospital.
 - The list of approved hospitals can be viewed via the QR Code or by accessing the website of www.presidentsfund.gov.lk or from your Divisional Secretariat.
- Should handover the application for medical assistance within the prescribed period.
- The total of the monthly income of the patient and all the family members should be less than Rs. 200,000.00
 - Income of the married children should not be considered while 50% of the monthly income generated by the single children should be considered for the family income.
- Being unable to reimburse the expenses incurred for surgeries/treatments from one’s reserved financial assets.
- Non coverage of 50% of the expenses by other donations, an insurance cover or other means.
- Non receipt of the approved maximum financial assistance.
- Furnishing true and accurate information.

Now you can hand over applications for obtaining financial assistance to the Divisional Secretariat to which your residential area belong.

Application

You can apply for benefits with the duly completed application for obtaining financial assistance of the President's Fund and all other necessary documents specified in the instruction sheet.

Application can be obtained by

- Downloading from the website of www.presidentsfund.gov.lk
- Scanning the QR Code

Method of Application

- The application can be handed over before 30 days to the surgery/treatment.

Or otherwise

- It can be handed over before exceeding 60 days from the date of discharge from the hospital after the surgery or treatment

Other Necessary Documents

- Original copy of the Medical Officer's recommendation related to the disease
- If the application is handed over prior to the surgery/treatment,
 - Original copy of the cost estimate for the surgery/treatment
- If the application is handed over after the surgery/treatment,
 - Original receipts of the payments made for surgery/treatment
- Bank Account Statements of the Patient and the family members (Recent 03 months)

- Photocopy of the Patient's National Identity Card
- Salary/Income particulars of the patient and family members (Wife or Husband / single children)
- Affidavits
- Copies of the documents in proof of loans obtained, gold pawning, if any
- Other necessary documents

How You Receive Benefits

- If you have applied for financial assistance after the surgery/treatment, you can obtain the benefits through the relevant Divisional Secretariats, if the President's Fund choose you as an eligible applicant for receiving such financial assistance
- If you have applied for financial assistance before the surgery/treatment, a letter of commitment should be issued to the relevant hospital by the President's Fund before the prescribed date of the surgery/treatment, if the President's Fund choose you as an eligible applicant for receiving such financial assistance

(The relevant hospital should submit the bills after your surgery/treatment and reimburse the cost from the President's Fund)
